Invested in Policing

This includes public safety services provided by the Ontario Provincial Police.

Your taxes fund 90.6% of these services.

Invested in Recreation Programs

This includes swim & day camp programs, Canada Day, Snow Social, and music events.

Your taxes fund 75.8% of these services.

Invested in Road Maintenance

This includes roads, bridges, brushing, sidewalks & winter maintenance.

Your taxes fund 89.1% of these services.

Invested in Public Safety

This includes fire, bylaw enforcement, animal control and emergency management.

Your taxes fund 85.4% of these services.

Invested in Support Services & Administration

This includes internal services such as the Clerk's office, Finance, Human Resources and Council.

Your taxes fund 61.1% of these services.

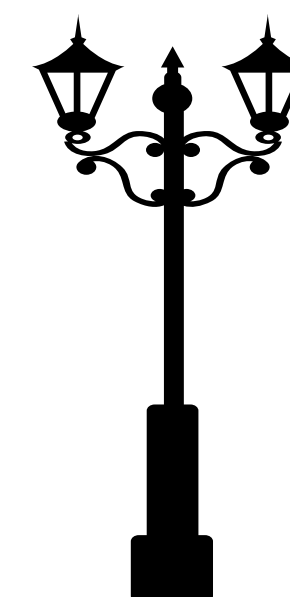
The Township's 2023 Budget results in an average tax payer increase of 2.62%.

Invested in Roads Safety

This includes road patrol, signage and streetlights.

Your taxes fund 90.8% of these services.

This includes garbage and recycling collection, operation of landfills, household hazardous waste depot and processing of materials.

Your taxes fund 50.7% of these services.



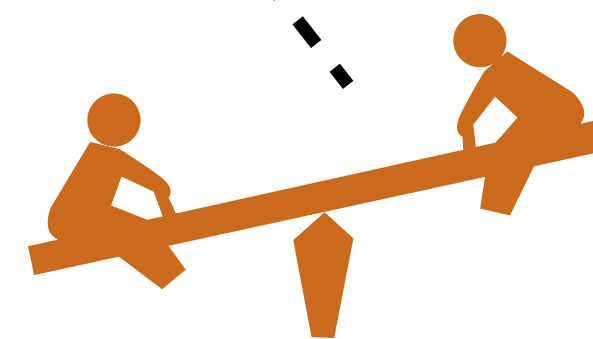

This includes land use planning, committee of adjustment, building inspections & permitting.

Your taxes fund 25.8% of these services.

Invested in Facilities, Public Spaces & Community Initiatives

This includes the maintenance of parks, public spaces, facilities and community initiatives such as the private lane assistance program, community grants program and grants to organizations.

Your taxes fund 59.3% of these services.

Invested in 2023 Capital Projects

This includes roads, bridges, facilities, fleet and equipment, parks and information technology. 76% of the capital budget is focused on renewal of our existing infrastructure. Your taxes fund 30.4% of these works.

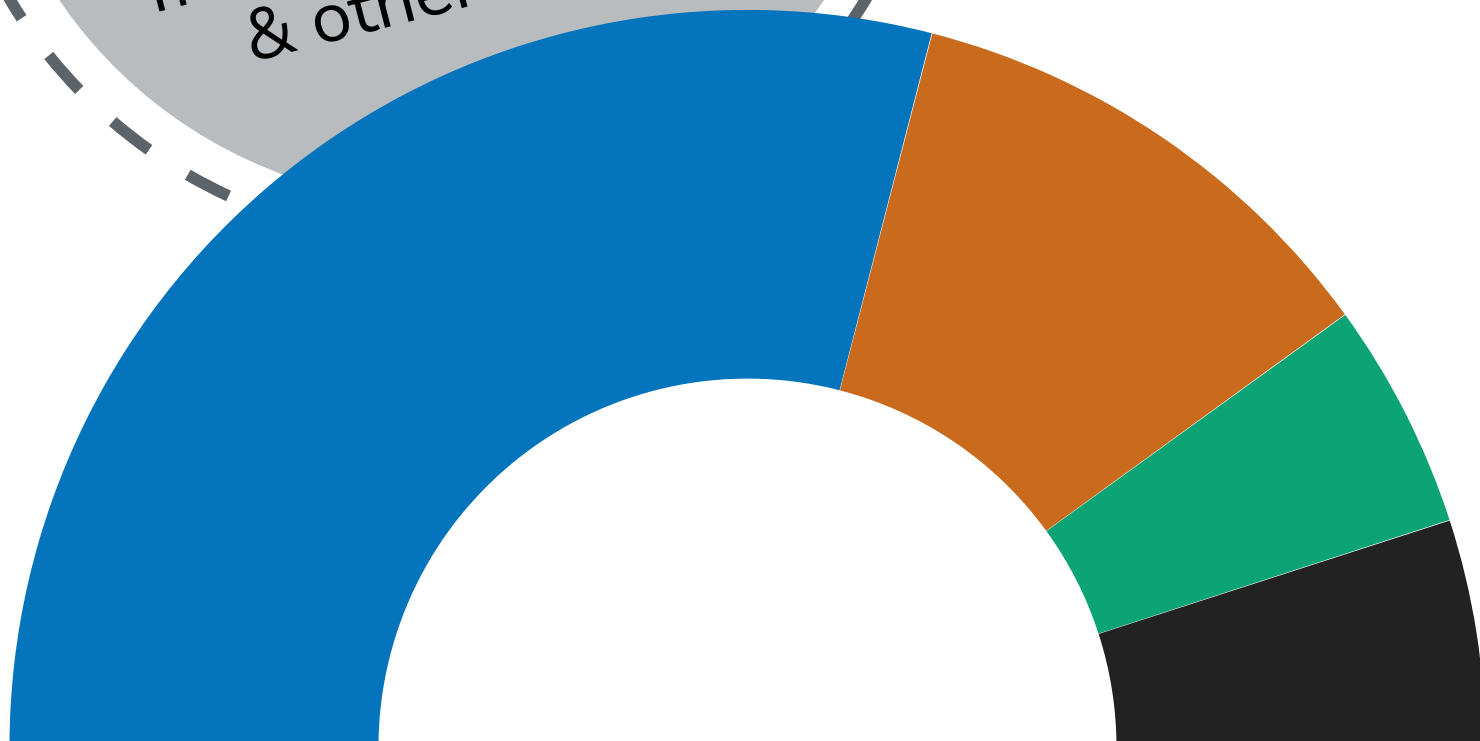
Invested in Capital Reserves

This includes contributions to reserves to meet long-range needs and financing of infrastructure growth and renewal. Your taxes fund 90.8% of these contributions.



Did You Know?

Property taxes account for 62.5% of South Frontenac's revenues. The rest come from reserves, grants & other sources.

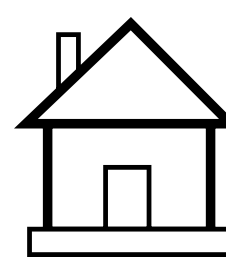


2023 PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

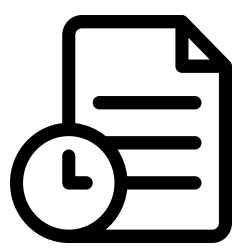
Projects for this year focus not only on meeting the needs of the community, but ensuring South Frontenac is positioned to grow and prosper in the future.

New events like Snow Social, Summer Kickoff Music Festival and our popular Music in the Park series.



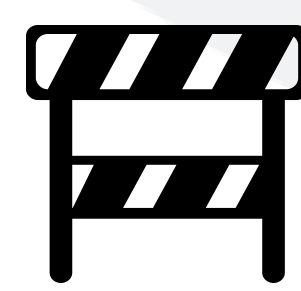
Important studies: Transportation Master Plan and Community Risk Assessment.



Court upgrades in Verona and Glendower.



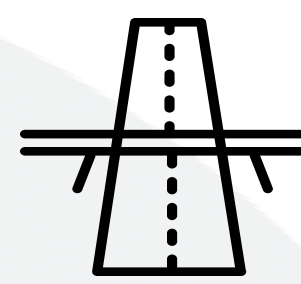
New playground equipment in Harrowsmith and Inverary.



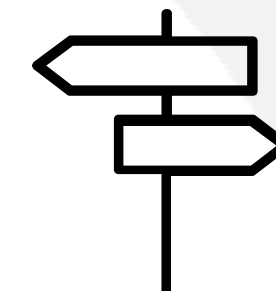
5-year plan for roads based on data in the Comprehensive Roads Needs Study.



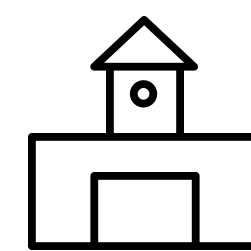
Road reconstruction (12 km) including Sunbury, Alton and North Shore Road. Pavement preservation work (27 km).



Road 38 design study.



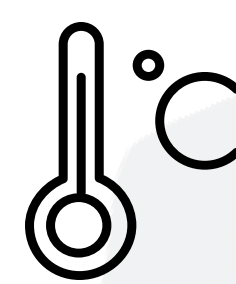
New or updated wayfinding signage throughout the Township.
