BY-LAW 2000-84

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2000-01 TO CREATE A REDUCED SPEED ZONE IN THE VICINITY OF PRINCE CHARLES PUBLIC SCHOOL IN VERONA

WHEREAS Bylaw 2000-01 regulates the use of and traffic, parking and stopping on highways and bridges under the jurisdiction of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Frontenac; and,

WHEREAS Section 128 (2) and (3) of the Highway Traffic Act, R. S. O. 1990, Chapter H.8, as amended provides that the council of a municipality may, by by-law, prescribe a rate of speed different from the rate of speed set out in Section 128 (1) of the said Act; and,

WHEREAS it is deemed useful to reduce the rate of speed in the vicinity of Prince Charles School in Verona;

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH FRONTENAC, BY ITS COUNCIL, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 2000-01 is hereby amended to create a reduced speed zone in the vicinity of Prince Charles School in Verona.
2. The reduced speed zone shall be centred on the school crosswalk and extend 200 metres north and south of the crosswalk.
3. The speed in the reduced speed zone shall be set at 40 kilometers per hour.
4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the erection of signs in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
