


BLUE BOX MATERIALS – BLUE WEEK

	<p>ALUMINUM & STEEL CANS</p> <p>CLEAN ALUMINUM FOIL/TRAYS</p>	<p>FOOD & BEVERAGE CANS & LIDS</p> <p>(flatten if possible) Clean aluminum foil, foil pie plates and foil baking trays</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NO</u></p> <p>Aerosols/paint cans</p> <p>Heavy metals (pots or pans)</p> <p>Foil laminates (potato chip/snack bags)</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">WHITE STYROFOAM TRAYS OR PACKAGING</p>	<p>WHITE GROCERY TRAYS and PACKING BLOCKS</p> <p>Blocks or sheets must be taped/tied into bundles no larger than 2'X3'X8" to ensure it does not get taken by the wind. Maximum 3 bundles per blue week</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NO</u></p> <p>Packing popcorn or peanut type</p> <p>Coloured Styrofoam of any kind</p>
	<p>PLASTICS (Food, beverage, health & beauty, non-hazardous cleaning supplies)</p> <p>BOTTLES; JUGS; TUBS; PLASTIC TAKEOUT CONTAINERS</p>	<p>Collapse bottles and Please do not overfill boxes (Net covers for sale at Keeley)</p> <p>Clean plant cells and pots up to 1 gallon & 12" wide.</p> <p>Clam Shells</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NO</u></p> <p>Motor oil or chemical containers (HHW)</p> <p>Plastic cutlery, plates, cups, straws or coffee pods-Bubble wrap/shrink wrap</p> <p>Hard plastic toys or pails</p>		CORROGATED CARDBOARD	<p>Corrugated Cardboard has more than 1 layer to it, usually with a waffle weave between layers</p> <p>Taped/tied into bundles no larger than 2'X3'X8" to ensure it does not get taken by the wind Maximum 3 bundles per blue week</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NO</u></p> <p>Mixing in boxboard (single ply)</p> <p>Waxy cardboard</p> <p>Cardboard contaminated with grease (pizza) or food particles</p> <p>Remove all staples and tape residue</p>

	<p>PAPER MAGAZINES BOXBOARD (CEREAL-CRACKER BOXES</p> <p>SINGLE PLY BOXBOARD</p>	<p>Junk Mail; Magazines; Soft cover books; hard covers must be removed; Fibre Egg Cartons</p> <p>Shredded Paper bagged in small grocery bags, limit 3 bags per yellow week</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NO</u></p> <p>Photographs, wrapping paper; tissue paper; used tissues or paper towels, candy wrappers</p> <p>Pet food, chip bags or coffee bags with foil liners</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">PLASTIC BAGS (FILM)</p>	<p>STRETCHABLE PLASTIC FILM ONLY</p> <p>Salt/wood pellet bags must have handles cut off, then rolled up and taped Ziplock bags must have "zippers cut off"</p> <p>Milk bags must be clean</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NO</u></p> <p>Heavy overwrap (mattress bags, plastic over pop flats)</p> <p>No soiled plastic wrap</p>
	<p>POLYCOAT GABLED CARTONS</p>	<p>Milk; Cream or Juice Cartons</p> <p>Cooking Broth boxes</p> <p>Drink Boxes (Tetra packs)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NO</u></p> <p>Straws</p> <p>Rinse thoroughly and flatten</p>		CONSUMABLE FOOD & BEVERAGE GRADE GLASS BOTTLES & JARS	<p>Clear or colored glass</p> <p>Empty & rinse, caps or lids may be left on</p> <p>Wine or alcohol bottles are accepted</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NO</u></p> <p>Mirror or plate glass Drinking glasses,</p> <p>Ceramics, mugs, serving dishes etc.</p> <p>Broken glass</p> <p>Light bulbs</p>
