**5. Staff Sergeant Report**

Staff Sergeant Ouellette reviewed the 2012 year end statistics and corresponding numbers for January 2013.

The representatives from the Contract Policing Unit have asked to reschedule discussions on the contract renewal. A date is to be determined in advance of the March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2013 Council meeting.

Staff Sergeant Ouellette will be filling in for region for the next two weeks.

Officers have contributed to a significant reduction in break and entry stats from 122 to 78.

Overall the detachments clearance rate for all property crimes is 35.8% compared to the regional average of 22.2%. Frontenac Detachment leads the region.

The clearance rate for violent crimes is 92%.

False alarms and pocket dials continue to be an ongoing problem.

2013 assaults are classified as domestic, between neighbours, school yard related and alcohol related.

2013 thefts include mailboxes, jewellery, dog and school based.

2012 overtime was up to 1435 hours, however given the budgeted allocation this represented about 45% of the budget. This savings should be reflected in the annual reconciliation.

While the 2012 Ride Statistics numbers are down by about 300 spot checks, the actions have resulted in more charges and achieved getting more drunk drivers off the road.
